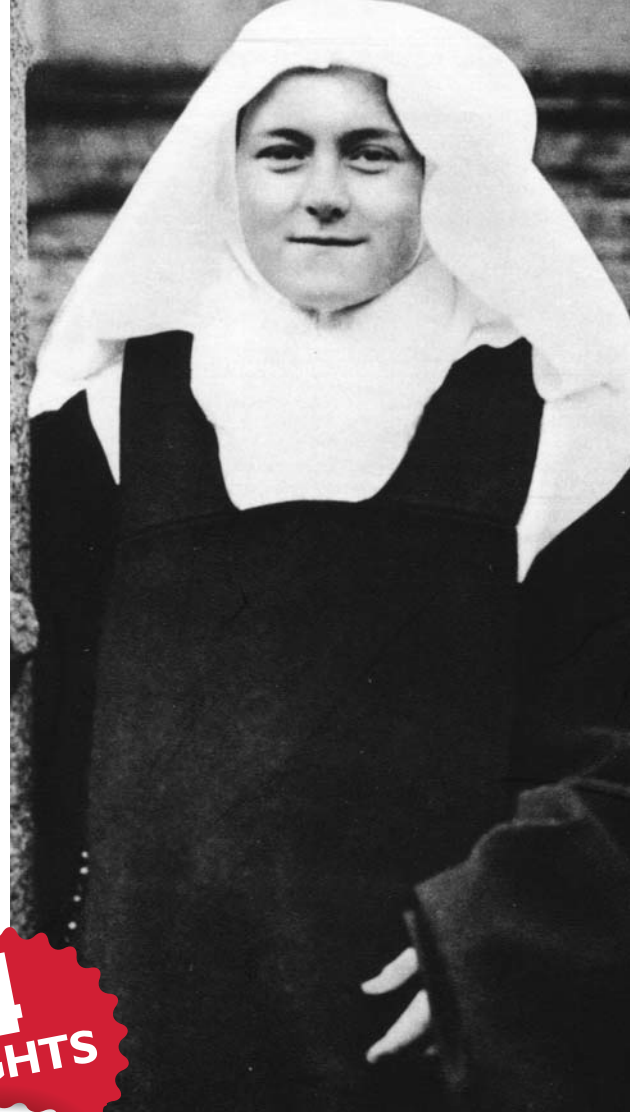

Breakfast in Hotel Esperance.

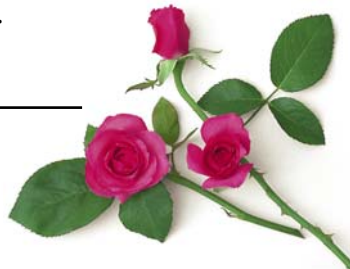
Pilgrimage Mass in Carmel Chapel.

SUNDAY – 27th SEPTEMBER

Breakfast in Hotel Esperance.

Solemn Pontifical Mass in the Basilica for the celebration of the feast of St Thérèse.

Afternoon procession of relics from the Basilica to St. Pierre Cathedral.

5pm Special Pilgrimage Mass in English in the Lady Chapel of the Cathedral of St Pierre where St. Thérèse and her father used to attend Mass.

MONDAY – 28th SEPTEMBER

Pilgrimage Mass in Carmel Chapel.

Depart Lisieux for Paris in time for check-in at Charles de Gaulle Airport for Aer Lingus flight to Dublin.

Passport

Valid up-to-date passport essential to travel to Lisieux. Holders of Non EU passports should check current regulations with relevant Embassy. Full name on application form **must** correspond to Christian and Surname on passport, otherwise Aer Lingus will charge a very substantial change fee.

Health Requirements

Before visiting an EU country, you should be in possession of a European Health Insurance Card. Certificate of entitlement to health services should be obtained from your local Health Board.

Booking Deposit

Please note Booking Deposit is €200. Deposit of €200 should be sent to St. Thérèse National Office, Whitefriar Street Church, 56 Aungier Street, Dublin 2. Cheques should be made payable to Pilgrimages Abroad.

Booking deposit is non-refundable.
